

**Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment**

**Assessment Overview:**

Zainab Higazi was assessed today, and findings indicate **developmental delays** that are likely due to **environmental factors** rather than genetic or neurological causes. The child **does not meet the criteria for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)** but requires **early intervention** to support her developmental progress.

The recommended plan includes **targeted therapy sessions** to enhance cognitive, speech, and motor development. **A follow-up reassessment in 3 months** will help evaluate her progress. If improvement is slow, **further analysis and specialized tests** will be required.

**Recommended Plan:**

**1) Immediate Intervention – Therapy Sessions:**

- **2 Speech Therapy (ST) sessions per week** – Focused on communication and language development.
- **1-2 Occupational Therapy (OT) sessions per week** – To support fine motor skills, sensory processing, and coordination.

**2) Follow-Up and Monitoring:**

- **Reevaluation in 3 months** to assess developmental progress.
- **If improvement is slow:** Additional tests, including **neurological and metabolic analysis**, may be required to identify underlying factors.

**Conclusion:**

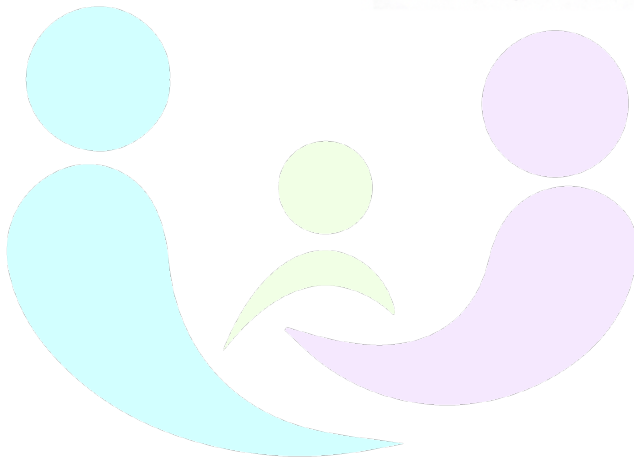
Zainab Higazi presents with **developmental delays attributed to environmental factors**. Early intervention with **structured therapy sessions** is crucial for her progress.
