Overview:

Muhammed-Muhammed attended our center for a developmental assessment on 31/07/2025. The evaluation revealed:

- Information Processing Delays
- Intellectual Developmental Delays
- Acquired Features of Autism
- Postivie MRI for white matter delays.

The child requires **further analyses** to identify contributing factors and guide a comprehensive intervention plan.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the information processing protocol for 4–6 months.
- Reevaluate in person to establish a baseline and monitor progress.
- Adjust the intervention plan according to the child's response.

2) Main Recommended Analysis (Based on Next Evaluation)

• Please refer to their report for assessment. These analyses are not done at EICADD.

3) Recommended Therapy

• Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy – Intensive, to start in later stages

• Speech Therapy (ST) and Occupational Therapy (OT) – To be continued at home

These therapies will target **cognitive processing**, **language**, **and daily functional skills** while preparing the child for future intensive neuroplasticity work.

Follow-Up

- Reevaluation every 4–6 months to assess progress and adapt therapy plans.
- Integrate Neurazon analysis results to personalize interventions for optimal outcomes.
