Assessment Summary:

Zaid Sami Habass was evaluated at our center to explore concerns regarding his developmental trajectory. The assessment revealed **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** that have led to **acquired features resembling autism**. However, the child **does not meet the criteria for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)** based on current observations and clinical benchmarks.

The developmental challenges observed are significant but fall under the category of delays rather than a confirmed neurodevelopmental disorder. Further analysis and structured intervention are necessary to determine the underlying causes and track progress over time.

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Begin an individualized development protocol tailored to support cognitive and sensory integration.
- Implement the intervention plan over a **4-month period**.
- Reevaluate the child **in person** at the end of the 4 months to review progress and update the strategy.
- Establish a clinical and developmental baseline for ongoing monitoring.

2) Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

- Please refer to their report and assessment.

3) Recommended Therapy:

- **Mitotherapy:**
 - 1–2 sessions per week of Light Therapy (LT) to support mitochondrial function and neural energy.
- **Speech and Occupational Therapy:**

- Continue the current therapy sessions with the center. These therapies are critical in improving expressive/receptive language, motor coordination, and cognitive adaptability.


