Overview:

Amir Chraf El Eslam visited our center for a follow-up developmental assessment. The child has shown significant improvement since the first stage of intervention. However, current findings indicate the presence of ongoing information processing delays and developmental delays. These are attributed to genetic variants, which have led to acquired features of autism and observable white matter delays.

Recommended Plan:

- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing
 - o Continue a non-medicinal developmental protocol.
 - o Duration: 4 months followed by reevaluation, preferably in person.
 - Objective: Reassess and establish a baseline, then adjust the plan accordingly.
- 2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):
 - Please refer to their report and assessment.
- 3. Recommended Therapy:
 - Intensive neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy (to be continued regularly)
