Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview

Abdulrahman-Nasser Husain attended a developmental progress assessment at EICADD Center Ajman. The assessment findings indicate **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, which are contributing to **learning difficulties**. At this stage, the child **does not meet scoring criteria as a case of autism**.

Genetic and developmental factors were identified as contributing to the child's profile; however, it is important to note that **many symptoms have already shown noticeable improvement**, indicating a **strong potential for further developmental progress** with continued and targeted intervention.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol

- Continue a structured **development protocol targeting information processing** for a period of **4 months**, followed by a **reevaluation**, preferably **in person**.
- During reevaluation, the plan will be reviewed and a **clear baseline** will be established to assess progress and guide subsequent stages.
- **Continue with the current intervention plan** consistently during this period.

2) Recommended Therapy

After determining the contributing causes and reviewing analysis results, the following therapy is recommended:

- **Plasticity rehabilitation therapy and/or Occupational Therapy (OT)**
 - Recommended frequency: **3 sessions per week**, adjusted as needed based on progress and tolerance.

Notes on External Testing

The recommended analysis is conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a bioinformatics company partnered with certified laboratories worldwide. Please refer to the plan provided by Neurazon for further information. Please note that this analysis is a **recommendation**, is **not obligatory**, and is **not conducted directly through our center**.

The child is open to improvement, and findings may change with progress and intervention. 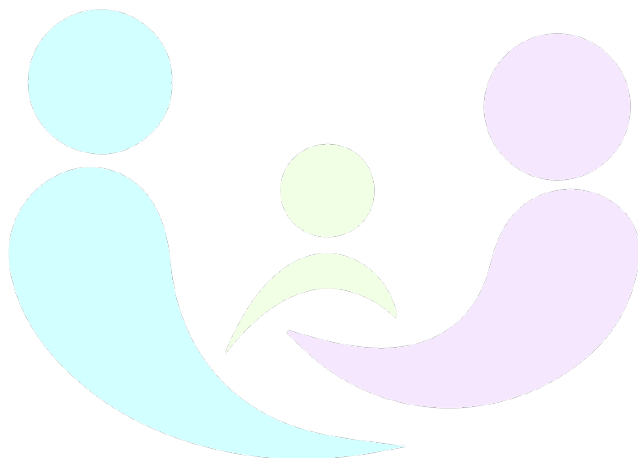
