Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Tariq Bouchina was reassessed at our center following the initial intervention protocol. The child has shown significant improvement and responded positively to the first phase of the developmental plan. However, information processing delays and developmental delays are still present and are believed to be linked to genetic variants previously identified.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Continue the protocol for an additional 4 months.
- Reassessment should be conducted in person to track progress and adjust interventions as needed.
- A baseline should be reestablished during the next evaluation to ensure measurable improvement continues.

2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

- At this stage, further testing is not required.
- Depending on the outcome of the next evaluation, specific tests may be recommended.

3. Recommended Therapy:

• Neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy (2–3 sessions per week) is recommended to further support cognitive and developmental growth.

Conclusion:

Tariq Bouchina has made encouraging progress under the first protocol. Continued therapy and structured follow-up will be essential in minimizing the remaining delays. This report serves as an ongoing assessment and is open to future revision based on the child's progress.
