Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Rayan Abdulrahman T. Al Harbi visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation revealed that the child has **Information Processing Delay** and **global developmental delays**, with **acquired features of autism**. However, based on the **Neurazon Precision Health Analysis** conducted externally, Rayan **does not score as a case of autism**, but rather as a case of **cognitive developmental delays**.

The child has shown **notable improvement** following the first protocol, indicating a **high potential for continued progress** with structured and consistent intervention. Although significant progress has been observed, further analysis and continued therapy are required to sustain and enhance developmental outcomes.

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the structured **information processing protocol** for **4 months**, followed by a **re-evaluation**, preferably conducted in person.
- Reassess developmental and cognitive progress and establish a new baseline.
- Continue consistent therapy sessions and ensure adherence to the developmental intervention schedule.

2) Main Recommended Analyses:

The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon** (**Canada**), a bioinformatics company partnered with accredited international laboratories. 3) Recommended Therapy:

- Rehabilitation Therapy (Plasticity Therapy / Occupational Therapy):
 Continue consistent therapy sessions focusing on neuroplasticity, sensory integration, and adaptive functioning.
 - o Introduce **intensive plasticity rehabilitation therapy** after 4 months to reinforce information processing and cognitive flexibility.
