### Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

#### Overview

Adam-Iyad was assessed for developmental functioning. Findings indicate **information processing delays with cognitive and intellectual developmental delays**. There are **clinical features suggestive of a chromosomal abnormality (e.g., Down syndrome)**; however, **no confirmatory genetic testing has been performed** to date. A comprehensive genetic assessment is recommended. Further analyses are advised to clarify contributing biological factors and to optimize the intervention plan.

#### Recommended Plan

##### 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Implement a structured protocol for **4 months** (attention, working memory, comprehension, processing speed).
- **Reevaluate in person** after 4 months to establish a clear baseline and adjust goals.
- Continue and adapt the intervention according to measured progress.

##### 2) Main Recommended Analyses (through Canada – Neurazon)

The Neurazon (Canada) tests are **recommendations, not obligatory**, and are **not conducted directly through our center**. Please refer to their report and assessment.

##### Clinical Genetics Referral (in parallel):

- Arrange **chromosomal testing** through local clinical genetics (e.g., **karyotype** and/or **chromosomal microarray**) to evaluate for **Down syndrome or other chromosomal abnormalities**, with counseling for the family.

### 3) Therapy

- **Speech Therapy and Occupational Therapy** to be initiated **in Saudi Arabia**, focusing on receptive/expressive language, social communication, sensory regulation, fine-motor skills, and daily-living routines. Provide progress notes to coordinate with the developmental program.

### Conclusion

This document reflects a developmental assessment. Adam-Iyad is **capable of improvement** with consistent therapy, coordinated genetic and developmental evaluations, and family engagement. Findings may evolve with progress and at the next in-person reassessment.

### Notes on External Testing

The Neurazon (Canada) tests listed above are **recommendations, not obligatory**, and are **not conducted directly through our center**. Clinical genetics testing should be arranged locally per medical standards.
