
Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Abdullah Al Mazrooei visited our center for a follow-up developmental progress assessment. The child has shown **significant improvement** following the initial intervention protocols. The assessment continues to reflect **information processing delays and developmental delays**, which have led to **acquired features of autism**. Further specialized analyses and structured therapies are required to support his ongoing development.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Continue for **3 months**, followed by in-person reassessment.
- Establish a new developmental baseline after reassessment.
- Complete the recommended session plan accordingly.

2. Main Recommended Analyses (to be repeated every 6–12 months):

3. Recommended Therapy (after 4 months of current protocol):

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:**
 - Frequency: **2–3 sessions per week**, to be started **as soon as possible** post reassessment.

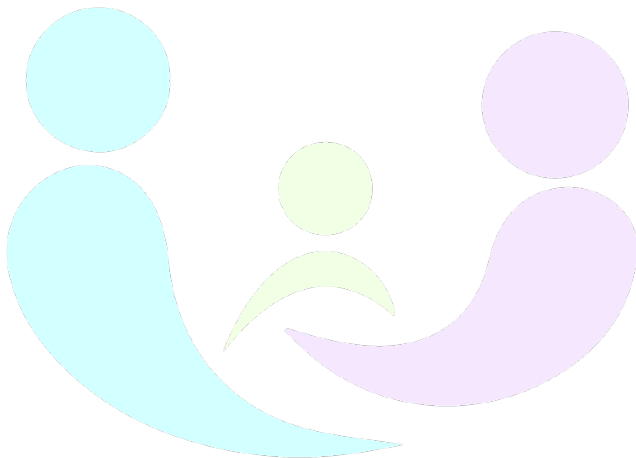
