Overview:

Ibraheem was assessed at our center due to parental concerns regarding his developmental profile. The assessment identified **information processing delays** and intellectual developmental delays traits leading to acquired features of autism. These features do not represent classical autism but appear to be the result of genetic cause and unresolved epileptic activity. **This Assessment was performed through Ostathna for education not EICADD or Alnakhla.**

We recommend to perform a full precision health analysis or Genetic Test (WES) as the cause appears to be genetic. Also, this test should be performed through a specialized center in Canada such Neurazon and professional health provided no through the center. Also, we recommend to follow up with a medical doctor and a neurologist.


We also recommend continuing on sessions and therapy at a specialized center for therapy in Lybia.
