Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Aylan Omar Alasad was assessed at our center on May 26th, 2025. The evaluation revealed that the child has clear **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, with early signs pointing toward **hyperlexia**, presenting features closer to **Hyperlexia Type 2**. However, the profile does not yet fully meet the criteria for this classification. The child demonstrates advanced reading or decoding abilities, but comprehension and language integration remain underdeveloped. These observations indicate the need for further clinical and functional investigation.

Recommended Plan:



1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Begin a structured intervention program for a duration of 4 months
- Conduct an in-person reevaluation following the initial protocol period
- Establish a baseline to measure future developmental and cognitive improvements
- Adjust the intervention plan based on observed response and progress

2) Main Recommended Analysis (through Neurazon – Canada):

3) Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:

• Mitotherapy Therapy: 2 to 3 sessions per week (based on readiness and tolerance)

• Occupational Therapy (OT): 2 sessions per week

• Speech Therapy (ST): 2 sessions per week
