

## Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

### Overview:

Abdalwahab Fares Alrasheedi was assessed at our center on July 1, 2025, as part of a follow-up developmental evaluation. The child has shown **notable improvement** following the initial stage of intervention. However, he continues to present with **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, leading to **acquired features of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)**. Based on prior medical imaging, including an MRI performed in Kuwait, these features are associated with **white matter delays** rather than being due to classic autism. Additionally, **learning difficulties** are evident and require targeted educational and neurodevelopmental support. Further assessments are necessary to guide a more specific treatment pathway.

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### Recommended Plan:

1. **Developmental Non-Medicinal Protocol for Information Processing:**
  - Continue for a period of **4 to 6 months**.
  - Reassessment should be conducted **in person** to track improvement and re-establish a developmental baseline.
  - Adjustments to the intervention plan will follow based on the child's progress.
2. **Recommended Testing (Conducted Through Neurazon – Canada):**
  - **Please refer to their report.**
3. **Recommended Therapy:**
  - **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy (Intensive):**
    - To be implemented promptly and adjusted based on the child's individual needs and tolerability.

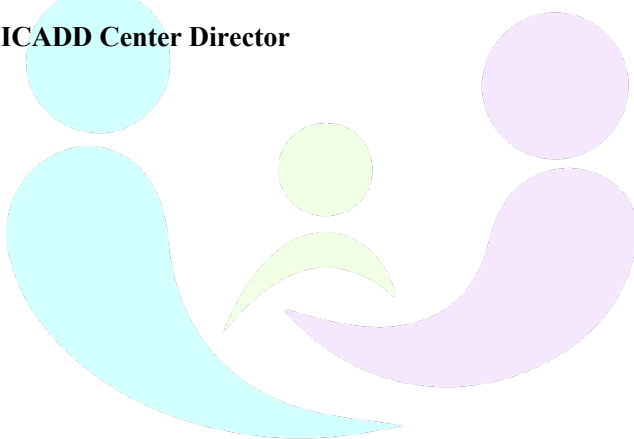
