
Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Date of Visit: 21-07-2025

Child's Name: Rayan-Saleh Alhamri

Date of Birth: 09-03-2020

Overview:

Rayan was assessed and found to have **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** that have contributed to **acquired features of autism**. However, based on the evaluation and screening, the child does **not meet the diagnostic threshold for classic autism**. Instead, the observed symptoms are more aligned with **features of intellectual developmental delays**, likely secondary to physiological and neurological processing issues. Continued evaluation and a structured intervention plan are recommended.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Continue for **4 months**
 - **In-person reevaluation** after this period
 - Establish an updated developmental baseline
 - Adjust and continue the intervention plan accordingly
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Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

Recommended Therapy:

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy** to be considered in **later stages** once readiness is confirmed in future evaluations



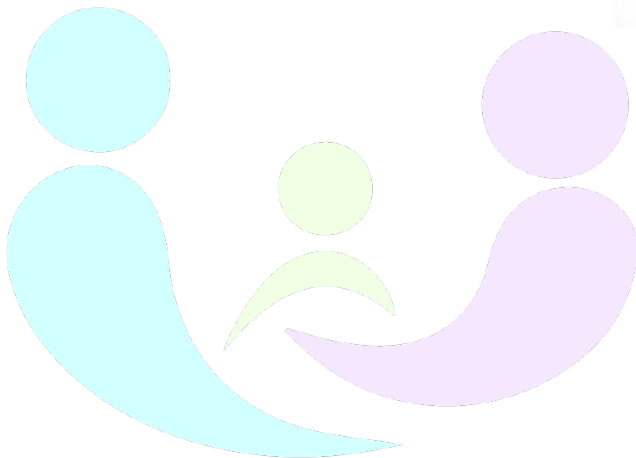
