Overview:

Ramah-Hameed Barman was assessed at our center on 29-07-2025. The child presents with information processing delays and global developmental delays leading to acquired features of autism. The assessment indicates the need for ongoing monitoring and supportive intervention to encourage developmental progress.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Apply the protocol for 4 months.
 - Reevaluate the child in person after 4 months.
 - Establish a baseline and continue with the intervention plan accordingly.

- Neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy (intensive to start in later stages).

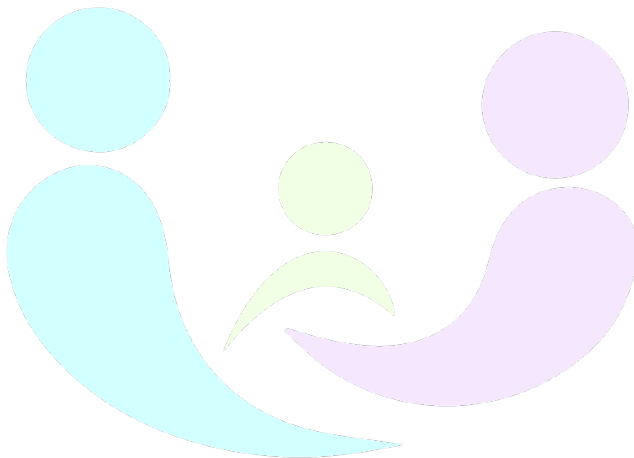
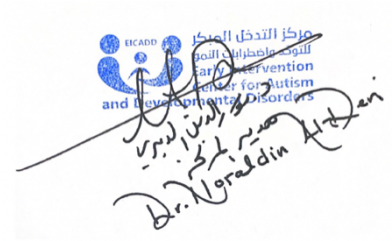
