Overview

Mohammed was assessed at our center for developmental progress. He presents with **information processing delays and developmental delays**, which are contributing to **learning difficulties**. Importantly, Mohammed does **not score as a case of autism or ADHD** at this stage. Further analyses are recommended to clarify the underlying contributors to his developmental profile and to guide the next steps in intervention.

Recommended Plan

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue with the intervention program for 4 months, followed by reevaluation, preferably in person.
- At reevaluation, establish a new baseline and refine the plan as necessary.
- Ensure structured developmental and educational support is maintained consistently.

2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada)

3. Recommended Therapy

He demonstrates delays in processing and learning, but with early intervention, proper monitoring, and therapy, he is capable of significant improvement. Continued analyses and consistent therapy will support his developmental trajectory.
