Developmental Progress Assessment Report

Overview

Hussei was assessed at Ostathna Center for developmental progress. The child has shown **great improvement on the first protocol**, indicating strong responsiveness to intervention and promising potential for further progress.

During the evaluation, the child presented with Information Processing Delays and intellectual developmental delays, which have led to features of hyperlexia closer to Hyperlexia Type 2. These characteristics include early interest in letters or reading, combined with delays in comprehension, communication, and processing.

Further structured intervention and additional analysis are recommended to better understand the underlying developmental factors. This report is a developmental assessment, not a final diagnosis.

Recommended Plan

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the protocol for 4 months, followed by a reevaluation preferably in person.
- Reassess the plan and establish a new **baseline** during the next evaluation.
- Continue the intervention plan to support processing, comprehension, and cognitive development.











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2. Main Recommended Analysis (For Later Stages)

These are external, optional assessments performed only through Neurazon (Canada).

3. Recommended Therapy (After Determining the Causes)

A. Rehabilitation Therapy

- Occupational Therapy: 2 sessions per week
- Speech Therapy: 2 sessions per week

These therapies support sensory processing, receptive/expressive language, comprehension, and learning development.

4. Potty Training Support (Recommended by Ostathna)

Hussei is at an age where structured potty-training support can be very helpful. Children with information-processing delays benefit from:

- Repetition
- Visual cues
- Simple language
- Songs and modeling videos
