### Overview

Abdulaziz was assessed at our center on 04-09-2025. The evaluation revealed that he previously demonstrated **information processing delays and developmental delays related to genetic variants**. However, he has **improved greatly on the first protocol**, with many of his earlier symptoms now resolved. These positive changes indicate a **high readiness for continued improvement** and strong potential for further progress with sustained interventions.

### Recommended Plan



### 1) Development Protocol for the Information Processing

- Continue a 4-month structured developmental protocol.
- Conduct a reevaluation after 4 months, preferably in person.
- Establish a baseline during reevaluation to track measurable progress.
- Continue and adapt the intervention plan as necessary.

### 2) Main Recommended Analyses (through Neurazon - Canada)

Recommended to repeat every 6–12 months:

### 3) Therapy

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:** Intensive therapy to begin immediately, as the child is now ready.
- Therapy should focus on **enhancing cognitive processing**, **language**, **and adaptive developmental skills** to build on the strong improvements already achieved.

### **Conclusion**

Abdulaziz has shown **substantial improvement following the first protocol**, with many of his prior challenges resolved. His readiness for intensive therapy and positive developmental trajectory strongly support the continuation of his intervention plan. With consistent support, there is a high likelihood of achieving further significant progress. A **reevaluation in 4 months** is essential to adjust the plan as needed.
