

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Assessment

Abdurahman was assessed in person at our center on 29-04-2025.

The evaluation findings revealed:

- **Information Processing Delays**
- **Features of Intellectual Developmental Delays**
- **Acquired Features of Autism**

These findings suggest that the child's developmental challenges may be linked to an **unresolved underlying physiological or genetic cause**. Further investigation is required to understand the source of these delays and to tailor an effective intervention plan. This assessment reflects a developmental and functional perspective and is not a final medical diagnosis. With appropriate intervention and support, the child shows capacity for improvement.

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Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Begin a structured therapy program focused on cognitive engagement, language development, executive function, and adaptive behavior.
- **Duration:** 4 months
- **Reevaluation:** In person after completing the initial therapy cycle to assess progress and update the protocol.
- **Goal:** Improve sensory processing, attention, memory, and communication readiness.

2) Recommended Tests (Through Neurazon – Canada)

- **Precision Health Analysis:**
A comprehensive assessment to identify genetic, metabolic, or functional causes contributing to the child's delays.
Sample: Saliva
Turnaround Time: 4 months (business days)

- **Neuronal Growth Factors Absorption Analysis:**

A test to evaluate the child's ability to absorb and utilize neurodevelopmental growth factors that are essential for brain function and plasticity.

Sample: Hair

Turnaround Time: 2 months (business days)

Frequency: Repeat every 6–12 months based on outcomes

Follow-Up Plan

- **Reassessment:**

After 4 months of therapy to reassess developmental gains and adapt the intervention plan accordingly.

- **Monitoring:**

Therapy session records, caregiver input, and progress notes will be reviewed to track improvements and guide next steps.


