

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Deyaa Ameen Alzawqari visited our center on 10-06-2025 for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation identified that Deyaa has information processing delays and intellectual developmental delays. In addition, he exhibits acquired features of autism. While the initial findings suggest developmental concerns, further analysis is necessary to determine the underlying causes and to tailor interventions effectively.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- A structured intervention plan will be implemented for 4 months.
- After this period, we will reevaluate Deyaa in person to establish a clear baseline and adjust the plan as needed.
- The intervention plan will continue based on the progress observed.

2. Recommended Tests (through Neurazon, Canada):

Please refer to their analysis and own report. These analysis is not done at our centers.

3. Recommended Therapy (post analysis):

- After 4 months and upon receiving the test results, initiate an intensive neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy program.
- This therapy will target Deyaa's information processing challenges and support overall brain development.



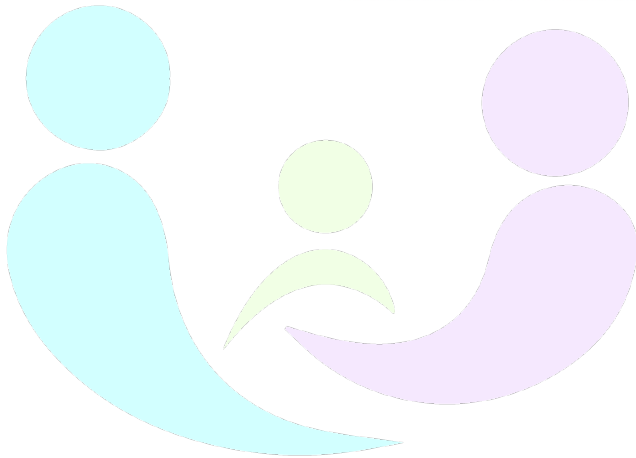
