Assessment Summary:

Ameer Mohammed Saleh was assessed at our center due to concerns related to academic and cognitive development. The assessment revealed **information processing delays** and **learning difficulties** that are currently impacting the child's performance and development. However, it is important to emphasize that the child **does not meet the clinical criteria for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)**.

The challenges presented fall within the scope of learning and cognitive processing difficulties, requiring structured support and further investigation into underlying causes to guide effective intervention.

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Begin an individualized developmental program focused on enhancing the child's information processing abilities.
- Continue the protocol over a **4-month** period.
- Conduct a follow-up **in-person reassessment** to evaluate the response to the intervention and adjust the plan accordingly.
- Establish a baseline to guide therapeutic direction.

2) Recommended Test through Neurazon (Canada):

3) Recommended Therapy:

- **Mitotherapy (Light Therapy):**
 - Frequency: 2 sessions per week to support mitochondrial function and enhance brain energy metabolism and focus.
