Overview

Tym visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The child has **improved greatly on the first protocol**, and many of the previous symptoms have been **fully resolved**. Based on the evaluation, Tym presents with a **simple developmental delay** and **does not score as a case of autism**, nor does he present with features of **ADHD or ADD**. His responsiveness to intervention indicates a **very high potential for continued improvement**.

This report reflects a developmental evaluation based on current observations and progress to date.

Recommended Plan

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the processing protocol for 4 months, followed by reevaluation preferably in person.
- Reevaluate the plan after 4 months and establish a new baseline.
- Complete all scheduled therapy sessions to support cognitive and developmental progress.
- 2. Main Recommended Analysis (Through Neurazon Canada)

These analyses are external, optional, and performed exclusively through Neurazon (Canada), a bioinformatics company partnered with accredited international laboratories.

3. Recommended Therapy

A. Rehabilitation Therapy

- Plasticity Therapy / Occupational Therapy (OT): Intensive sessions recommended.
- Occupational Therapy (OT) and Speech Therapy (ST) should continue according to the structured plan established for Tym.

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Notes on External Testing

All recommended tests are performed **only through Neurazon** (Canada). These are **recommendations**, not requirements. The purpose is to further understand biological contributors to the child's development.

Conclusion

This is **not a final diagnosis**, but a developmental assessment based on current findings. Tym shows **significant improvement**, and with continued therapy and structured support, further progress is expected.
