
Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Shahm Shadi Albalus was assessed on 30-09-2025 at EICADD Center Ajman. The evaluation revealed **information processing delays and global developmental delays leading to acquired features of autism**; however, **he does not score as a case of autism**. Further analyses are recommended to better understand the underlying contributing factors.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue a structured developmental protocol for **4 months**, followed by an in-person reassessment.
 - Re-evaluate progress and establish a new baseline after the follow-up assessment.
 - Continue with the intervention plan as guided by progress outcomes.
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2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

Testing can be **postponed for later stages** if needed.

- **Precision Health Analysis – Neurazon (Canada)**
 - Provides a more detailed understanding of contributing factors.
 - **Sample:** Saliva.
 - **Turnaround Time:** Approximately **4 months (business days)** for results.

Note: The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a **bioinformatics company partnered with certified laboratories worldwide**. 3. Recommended Therapy:

- **Rehabilitation Therapy:**
 - **Speech Therapy (ST):** 1–2 sessions/week
 - **Occupational Therapy (OT):** 1–2 sessions/week
 - **Light Therapy (LT):** 1–2 sessions/week
