Assessment Summary:

Shko was assessed for concerns related to cognitive and language development. The evaluation revealed **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**. Notably, Shko exhibits features consistent with **Hyperlexia**, leaning towards **Type 3**, although he does not fully meet the criteria for a definitive classification. Hyperlexia Type 3 typically presents with early reading skills alongside social and language difficulties, often mistaken for autism. Shko's current profile indicates the need for deeper evaluation to understand the root causes and guide an effective intervention plan.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Begin an individualized intervention protocol focused on improving processing speed, comprehension, and integrative learning.
- Duration: 4 months, followed by a re-evaluation (preferably in person).
- During the reevaluation:
 - Assess developmental gains.
 - o Establish a new baseline for continued intervention.
 - o Adjust the protocol according to observed progress.

2. Recommended Diagnostic Tests (through Neurazon – Canada):

Note: Tests are external and processed via Neurazon (Canada). These are **recommendations** and **not obligatory**, and they are **not conducted through our centers directly**. Please refer to their report.







3. Recommended Therapy (Post-Cause Determination):

- Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy (Intensive)
 - o To be initiated as soon as possible.
 - o Focus: Enhancing cognitive flexibility, attention regulation, and integrative learning using targeted, science-based neurorehabilitation techniques.
 - Duration and frequency to be determined based on individual response and updated baseline.
