Recommended Plan

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the **development protocol for 4 months**.
- **Reevaluate after 4 months**, preferably in person, to establish a new baseline and adjust the plan as needed.
- Maintain **consistent parent-guided follow-up at home** to reinforce therapy gains.

2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada)

Note: The recommended tests are **conducted externally through Neurazon (Canada)**, a **bioinformatics company partnered with certified international laboratories**.

3. Recommended Therapy

- **Speech Therapy:** 1–2 sessions per week.
- **Occupational Therapy:** 1–2 sessions per week.
- **LT Therapy:** 2 sessions per week to address receptive-expressive language, sensory integration, and early communication.

Aseil's profile emphasizes the importance of **early and intensive intervention**. The combination of a **4-month developmental protocol, regular speech, occupational, and LT therapy**, along with **recommended external analyses**, is expected to support improved communication, sensory regulation, and overall developmental progress.
