Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Mohammed was assessed on 30-09-2025 at Ostathna – Jordan.

The evaluation revealed information-processing delays and developmental delays leading to hyperlexia-like features. These features appear to be primarily related to information-processing challenges and the need for plasticity rehabilitation, rather than classical hyperlexia subtypes.

Mohammed requires **further analyses** to better understand underlying contributing factors and to guide the next steps of his intervention plan.

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Continue with the developmental protocol for 4 months, then re-evaluate the child in person.
- At the follow-up, establish a **baseline** and adjust the intervention plan accordingly.
- Continue with the current intervention protocol as advised.











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2) Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

The recommended tests are conducted through Neurazon (Canada), a bioinformatics company partnered with certified laboratories worldwide. 3) Recommended Therapy:

- OT Plasticity Rehabilitation Therapy: To be introduced at later stages when the child is ready.
- Rehabilitation Therapy: Continue as part of the long-term developmental plan.


