Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Mohammed Ibrahim Salim was evaluated at our center on 12-06-2025. The assessment revealed **information processing delays**, **cognitive developmental delays**, and **acquired features of autism**. These concerns affect his ability to effectively process sensory and cognitive input and respond appropriately during developmental tasks. The signs of autism appear to be acquired rather than rooted in a genetic core, which makes early intervention essential. Additional analysis is required to identify underlying physiological or metabolic causes and to tailor interventions accordingly.

Recommended Plan:



- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:
 - o Initiate a structured developmental intervention protocol targeting information processing and cognitive function.
 - Duration: 4 months.
 - o Conduct a full reevaluation at the end of the 4-month period (preferably in person) to assess progress and adjust the plan accordingly.
 - o Continue with revised interventions based on the outcomes.
- 2. Recommended Tests (through Neurazon Canada):
 - Please refer to their report. These tests are not done at EICADD.
- 3. Recommended Therapy (post-analysis):
 - Once the underlying causes are reviewed, intensive neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy should begin.
 - o This specialized intervention is designed to strengthen neural pathways, enhance cognitive function, and support developmental progress.
