

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Ali was assessed at our center for developmental progress and information processing abilities. The evaluation revealed delays in both information processing and overall development, leading to acquired features of autism. However, the child does not meet the criteria for an autism diagnosis. Ali has shown **notable improvement** on the first protocol, and with continued targeted support, further developmental progress is expected.

Recommended Plan:

1. **Development Protocol for Information Processing:**
 - Continue for 4 months, followed by reevaluation (preferably in person).
 - Establish a new baseline upon reassessment.
 - Continue the intervention plan according to progress.
2. **Main Recommended Analysis:**
 - Please refer to their report and assessment. These analyses are not done at EICADD.
3. **Recommended Therapy:**
 - **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy** – Intensive program to start in later stages when the child is developmentally ready.


