Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview

Tamim Sanad Al Utaibi was assessed at our center on 03-09-2025. The evaluation revealed that the child has shown **significant improvement following the first protocol**. Initially, Tamim presented with **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** attributed to genetic variants. Since then, **many of the previous symptoms have been resolved**, highlighting positive responsiveness to intervention.

Continued structured therapy and periodic reassessment are recommended to sustain and further enhance developmental progress.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue with a structured **4-month developmental protocol**, followed by an **in-person reevaluation**.
- Establish a **baseline** at the next evaluation to objectively measure progress.
- Maintain and refine the intervention plan based on outcomes.

2) Main Recommended Analyses (through Neurazon – Canada), not done at EICADD

To be repeated **every 6–12 months** for optimal monitoring:

- **Neuronal Growth Factors Absorption Analysis – NGF© (Canada)**

- Provides insights into neuronal growth factor absorption that influences cognitive and developmental function.
- **Sample required:** Hair.
- **Timeline:** ~2 months business days for results.
- **Frequency:** Every 6–12 months.

3) Therapy Recommendations

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:** Intensive program to begin as soon as possible, with multiple sessions per week to maximize gains in cognitive flexibility, learning capacity, and developmental outcomes.

Conclusion

Tamim has demonstrated **great improvement under the first protocol**, with resolution of many earlier symptoms. Continued adherence to a structured development protocol, supported by **intensive neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy** and **periodic Neurazon analyses**, will help ensure sustained progress. A **reevaluation in 4 months** is strongly advised to adjust and optimize the intervention plan


