

## **Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment**

**Date of Visit:** 13-07-2025

**Child's Name:** Shaikha Saeed Alali

**Date of Birth:** 18-10-2018

### **Overview:**

Shaikha was assessed and found to have **information processing delays** and **regression in developmental milestones**, along with features of **intellectual developmental delays**. These issues have led to **acquired features of autism**, although not considered a definitive diagnosis. The child requires further evaluation and targeted intervention to support neurological and cognitive development.

### **Recommended Plan:**

#### **1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:**

- Duration: 3–4 months
- In-person reevaluation after this period
- Establish a clear developmental baseline
- Continue structured, non-medicinal intervention

### **Main Recommended Analysis (through Neurazon – Canada):**

### **Recommended Therapy:**

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:**
  - To be introduced in later stages after baseline improvement is observed through the initial development protocol

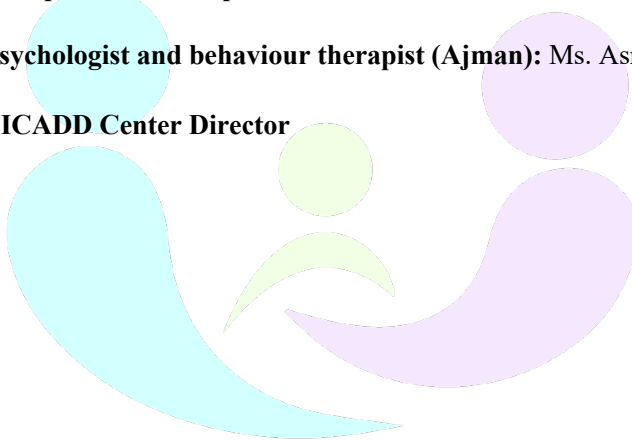

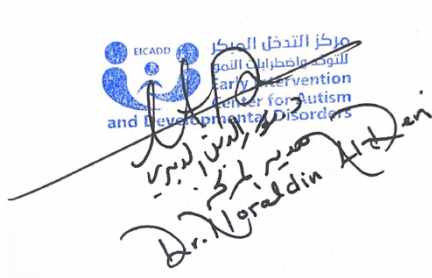
