### Overview

Sheikh Khalid attended our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation indicates **information processing delays and global developmental delays**, which have contributed to **acquired features of autism**. These findings reflect challenges in processing information, communication development, and adaptive skills.

This is not a fixed diagnosis; rather, it indicates areas that need **targeted early intervention**. With structured support and continued monitoring, positive developmental progress is expected. Further analysis is needed to better understand the developmental profile and tailor long-term plans.

### Recommended Plan

#### 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the structured development protocol for **4 months**
- Reassessment after 4 months, preferably in person
- Review progress, update developmental baseline, and continue intervention

#### 2) Recommended Analyses Through Neurazon (Canada)

The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a bioinformatics company partnered with accredited global laboratories. These tests are **external and not performed at our center**.

They are **recommendations, not mandatory**, and are offered to provide deeper insights for individualized interventions.

#### 3) Recommended Therapy

- **Plasticity Rehabilitation Therapy** (in later stages when child is ready)
- **Speech Therapy & Occupational Therapy – Continue regularly**
