#### **Overview:**

Joud Mohamed Jasim Mohamed Al Hammadi was assessed at our center for developmental evaluation. The assessment findings indicate **information processing delays** and **intellectual developmental delays**, which are contributing to **acquired features of autism**. These features are not due to classical autism but are secondary to the underlying processing and developmental delays. The child requires further evaluation to identify the root causes and to tailor a comprehensive intervention plan.

#### **Recommended Plan:**

# EIGADD

### 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Initiate a structured developmental program focusing on cognitive and sensory processing improvement.
- Duration: 4 months, followed by reassessment.
- Reevaluate the child's baseline and adjust the intervention as needed after the initial period.

## **Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:**

- Neuroplasticity Therapy
  - o To begin **after the initial 4-month protocol**, depending on the outcomes and updated evaluation.
- Speech and Occupational Therapy
  - To support the development of communication, fine motor skills, and adaptive functioning.
