Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Assessment

Abdulaziz visited our center for a developmental progress evaluation on 26-04-2025. The assessment revealed that the child presents with:

- Global Developmental Delays
- Intellectual Developmental Delays
- Epileptic based on neurologist assessment

At this stage, the child requires further analysis to better understand the underlying causes affecting his developmental trajectory.

This evaluation is based on the child's current developmental and cognitive presentation and is intended to guide intervention planning. It is not a medical diagnosis. Abdulaziz shows potential for progress with structured intervention and continuous monitoring.

Recommended Plan

- 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing
 - Initiate targeted cognitive rehabilitation sessions focusing on enhancing information processing speed, cognitive flexibility, and language development.
 - **Duration:** 3–4 months
 - **Reevaluation:** After 3–4 months, preferably in person, to assess the developmental baseline and adjust the intervention plan accordingly.

2) Recommended Tests

• Precision Health Analysis – Recommended by Neurazon (Canada):

A comprehensive analysis aimed at identifying potential underlying genetic, metabolic, or functional causes contributing to the developmental delays.

Sample: Saliva

Turnaround Time: 4 months business days.





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3) Recommended Therapy

- Rehabilitation Therapy Protocol:
 - Format per session day:
 - 1 Speech Therapy Session (ST)
 - 1 Occupational Therapy Session (OT)
 - 1 Light Therapy Session
 - Goal: Multi-modal stimulation of cognitive, motor, sensory, and neuronal growth pathways to support holistic development.

Follow-Up Plan

• Reassessment:

Scheduled after completing the 3–4 month intervention phase to evaluate developmental improvements and determine the next steps.

• Continuous Monitoring:

Behavioral observations during therapy, therapist feedback, and parental reporting will be systematically collected and reviewed.

Ongoing evaluation and structured intervention are essential to support Abdulaziz's future developmental trajectory.
