Overview

Abdulmalik visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The child has shown clear improvement following the first protocol, reflecting high potential for continued developmental progress. Previous analyses conducted externally through Neurazon (Canada) identified certain variants influencing neurodevelopment, which contribute to developmental delays and acquired features of autism. However, Abdulmalik does not score as a case of autism, and his presentation aligns more with developmental delays rather than autism spectrum disorder.

The pattern of improvement shows strong responsiveness to intervention, and the child remains highly capable of further improvement with structured therapy and developmental support. This assessment is not a final diagnosis but represents Abdulmalik's developmental status based on current observations.

Recommended Plan

EIGADD

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the protocol for 4 months, followed by reevaluation preferably in person.
- Reevaluate the plan and establish a clear baseline during the next visit.
- Complete the scheduled therapy sessions as part of the intervention plan.

2. Main Recommended Analysis (Through Neurazon – Canada)

The recommended analyses are conducted through Neurazon (Canada), a bioinformatics company partnered with certified laboratories worldwide. These tests are external, optional, and not performed directly through our centers. Please refer to the Neurazon plan for further details.

3. Recommended Therapy

A. Rehabilitation Therapy

• Plasticity Therapy / Occupational Therapy (OT): Intensive blocks of 1–2 weeks every month over 4 months, with the option to increase intensity if possible.

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This is essential to enhance cognitive processing, neuroplasticity, communication, and motor-sensory development.

Notes on External Testing

All recommended analyses are performed **only through Neurazon (Canada)**, an external bioinformatics center partnered with internationally accredited laboratories. These are **recommendations**, not obligations, and are not performed through EICADD Center.

Conclusion

This assessment is **not** a **final diagnosis** but a developmental evaluation based on current findings. Abdulmalik has demonstrated meaningful improvement and retains **high potential for further progress**. With continued therapy and adherence to the intervention plan, additional developmental gains are expected.
