Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Assessment

Rayan was assessed in person at our center on 28-04-2025. The evaluation findings revealed:

- The child has **improved** following the first phase of the developmental intervention protocols.
- The child continues to present with Information Processing Delays and Intellectual Developmental Delays.
- Acquired features of Autism were also observed, highlighting challenges particularly in cognitive flexibility and adaptive behaviors.
- Behavioral delays remain significant and indicate the need for intensive behavioral therapy to support emotional regulation, attention control, and social interaction development.

This assessment provides a developmental and functional analysis for therapy planning purposes and is not a final medical diagnosis.

Rayan shows potential for meaningful developmental progress with a structured and consistent intervention plan.

Recommended Plan

- 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing
 - Continue targeted interventions focusing on enhancing cognitive processing, executive function, social communication, and behavioral regulation.
 - **Duration:** 4–6 months
 - **Reevaluation:** Preferably in person after completing the intervention phase to reassess developmental progress and establish a new therapy baseline.
 - Goal: Improve cognitive efficiency, behavioral adaptation, and social interaction skills.
 - Therapy Focus:
 - Light Therapy Sessions:
 - 1–2 sessions per week
 - Aimed at supporting neuronal activation, mood regulation, and improving cognitive responsiveness.





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2) Recommended Tests

• Future Testing Considerations:

No further analysis is required at this time.

Additional functional or genetic testing may be reconsidered based on the child's progress during the upcoming months.

Follow-Up Plan

• Reassessment:

Scheduled after 4–6 months of consistent therapy to evaluate cognitive, behavioral, and adaptive functioning improvements.

• Continuous Monitoring:

Documentation of therapy outcomes, behavioral observations, and parental feedback will guide any necessary therapy adjustments.

A structured multidisciplinary approach remains crucial for maximizing Rayan's developmental potential.
