Overview:

Badreyah was assessed at our center for developmental evaluation. The findings indicate **information processing delays and regression in developmental milestones**, along with **intellectual developmental features** that have resulted in **acquired features of autism**. These features are not permanent and can improve with proper intervention. The child requires further observation and tailored support to enhance developmental outcomes.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Initiate a non-medicinal intervention protocol focusing on information processing delays.
 - Duration: **3 to 4 months**, followed by in-person reassessment.
 - Establish a clinical baseline for future tracking.
 - Continue with the personalized intervention plan based on observed responses.

Recommended Therapy:

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy**

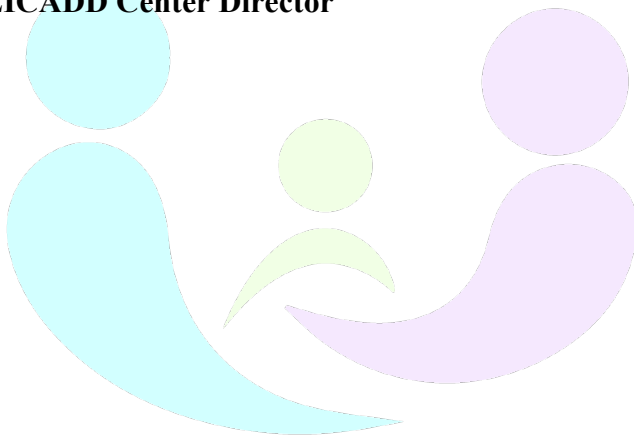


