### **Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment**

### **Overview:**

Mubarak Zamanan was assessed at our center on July 1, 2025. The evaluation revealed **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, which have contributed to **acquired features of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)**. These features are not considered classic autism but are instead secondary to the child's current developmental challenges. The child shows potential for improvement and adaptation with early and targeted intervention. Further analysis is needed to identify the root causes and tailor the intervention plan accordingly.

### **Recommended Plan:**

1. **Development Protocol for Information Processing:**
  - Duration: Continue for **4 months**, followed by a comprehensive reassessment.
  - Reassessment: Preferably conducted **in person** to ensure accuracy.
  - Goal: Establish a clear developmental baseline and adjust the intervention strategy as needed.
2. **Recommended Testing (via Neurazon – Canada):**
  - **Please refer to their report and assessment.**
3. **Therapeutic Recommendation (Post-Analysis):**
  - **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy**
    - To be initiated at later stages, based on the findings of the above analyses.



