**Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment**

### **Overview:**

Karam-Faud Alshare visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The child has shown **significant improvement on the first protocol**, demonstrating progress across multiple developmental domains.

The evaluation indicates that Karam has information processing delays and developmental delays that are linked to genetic variants affecting developmental pathways, as identified in a previous Precision Health Analysis conducted externally. These factors have contributed to acquired features of autism, which have been improving through continuous intervention and therapy.

The child's developmental trajectory remains positive, and his response to intervention suggests high neuroplastic potential and ongoing progress with the current plan.

### **Recommended Plan:**

#### 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue with the current **developmental protocol** for 4 months, followed by a **reevaluation**, preferably conducted in person.
- Reassess the progress and establish a **new developmental baseline**.
- Continue with the **current intervention plan**, adjusting as needed to target ongoing areas of improvement.

#### 2) Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon** (**Canada**), a bioinformatics company partnered with accredited international laboratories. These tests are **external**, **not obligatory**, and **not conducted directly through our center**. Parents are encouraged to follow the plan

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provided by Neurazon for further details regarding sample collection, processing, and reporting timelines.

## 3) Recommended Therapy:

- Rehabilitation Therapy: Continue with Plasticity Therapy at an intensive level to reinforce neurodevelopmental and cognitive progress.
- Maintain multidisciplinary support, including occupational and behavioral therapy, as complementary components to the plasticity plan.
