Overview

Balqees Majid Al-Edwan was assessed at **Ostathna** on 01 October 2025.

The evaluation revealed **information-processing delays** and **global developmental delays**, which have contributed to **intellectual developmental delays** and **acquired features of autism**. A tailored, multidisciplinary approach is recommended to support Balqees' learning, social participation, and long-term developmental progress.

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Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the structured development protocol for **4 months**.
- Reassess after 4 months — preferably **in person** — to establish a new baseline and adjust the intervention plan.
- Maintain ongoing intervention to strengthen cognitive and adaptive skills.

2) Recommended Tests – Conducted through Neurazon (Canada)

Notes on External Testing:

These tests are provided through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a bio-informatics company partnered with certified international laboratories.

They are **external to Ostathna** and **not obligatory**; parents may choose them for deeper biomedical insight as advised in the care plan.

3) Recommended Therapy

- **Rehabilitation Therapy:** Continue multidisciplinary sessions targeting speech-language, cognitive, and motor development.
- **Shadow Teacher:** Recommended in the classroom to provide one-on-one support, improve participation, and bridge gaps in information processing and academic skills.

Conclusion

Balkees demonstrates **information-processing and global developmental delays** that have led to **intellectual developmental delays** and **acquired autism-like features**.

A combined approach of consistent rehabilitation, classroom support with a **shadow teacher**, and optional biomedical testing will help guide a personalized plan to maximize her developmental and educational outcomes.

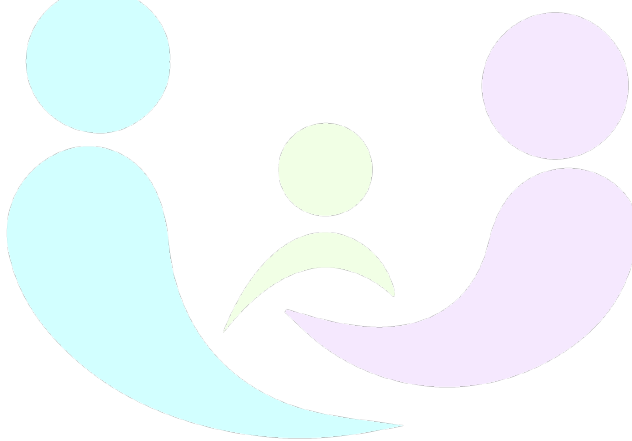
