

## Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

### Overview:

Kenz-Noor Sayed visited our center for a **developmental progress assessment**. The evaluation indicates the presence of **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** leading to **hyperlexia**, closer to **Hyperlexia Type 2**, which represents **acquired features of high-functioning autism**.

Children with Hyperlexia Type 2 often demonstrate **advanced word recognition skills** alongside challenges in **language comprehension, social interaction, and flexible communication**. This profile suggests strong visual learning abilities and memory retention but ongoing developmental challenges that require structured support and targeted therapies.

Further **analyses are recommended** to better understand the biological and metabolic contributors influencing Kenz-Noor's developmental and cognitive profile.

### Recommended Plan:

#### 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Continue the structured development protocol for **4 months**, followed by a reassessment (preferably in person).
- Reevaluate the plan and establish a developmental baseline at the next visit.
- Continue with the intervention plan focusing on speech, comprehension, and social adaptive development.

#### 2) Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

The recommended analyses are conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a bioinformatics company partnered with accredited international laboratories. These tests are **external** and not conducted directly through our centers.

### 3) Recommended Therapy:

- **Rehabilitation Therapy:** Plasticity therapy (to start in later stages).
- **Occupational Therapy and Speech Therapy:** Recommended to continue regularly to improve fine motor, communication, and comprehension skills.
