Assessment Summary:

This is the **second assessment** for Ali Alghabesh at our center. Compared to the previous evaluation, the child has **improved greatly** in various developmental domains. However, current observations still indicate **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, which have previously contributed to **acquired features of autism**.

Following the Precision Health Analysis conducted by Neurazon, the delays appear to be linked to mitochondrial variants and other physiological findings, rather than a primary autism diagnosis. The child continues to present with developmental challenges, but he does not meet the criteria for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Continue with the personalized developmental protocol for an additional 4 months.
- Reevaluate the child in person at the end of this period.
- Establish a new baseline reflecting current progress and adapt the intervention plan as needed.

- Neuroplasticity Therapy (Intensive):
