

## Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

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### Overview:

Saif was reassessed at our center after completing his first protocol, where he demonstrated measurable improvements. Despite this progress, the evaluation indicated **information processing delays and developmental delays**, which are associated with identified genetic variants.

Further analyses are required to better understand the underlying biomedical and developmental contributors.

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### Recommended Plan:

EICADD

#### 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Implement a structured intervention plan targeting processing and cognitive function.
- Duration: 4 months, with a follow-up reassessment (preferably in person).
- Establish a **baseline** at reevaluation to adjust strategies as needed.
- Continue ongoing intervention to reinforce developmental growth.

#### 2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

#### 3. Recommended Therapy

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:**
  - Frequency: 2–3 sessions per week.
  - Focused on strengthening cognitive flexibility, comprehension, and adaptive learning skills.

Saif has shown encouraging progress under the initial protocol, and with continued therapy and follow-up testing, further improvements are expected. Consistent reassessment will be important to refine his plan and track developmental outcomes.


