Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Abdulaziz was assessed at our center for developmental concerns. The assessment revealed **information processing delays** and **intellectual developmental delays**, which have contributed to **acquired features of autism**. The child displays signs that indicate a delay in integrating verbal, cognitive, and processing tasks in a typical age-appropriate manner. These signs are considered acquired and can improve significantly with targeted and timely intervention.

Recommended Plan:



1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Initiate a non-chemical development protocol
- Continue the intervention for 4 months
- Reevaluate the child's progress in person to set a clear baseline and monitor improvement
- Adapt and continue sessions based on the response

2) Main Recommended Analysis (via Neurazon – Canada):

3) Recommended Therapy:

- Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy
 - o Recommended for later stages, to begin after 2 months based on progress
- Occupational and Rehabilitation Speech Therapy
 - o Can be pursued locally in the child's home country
 - Focused on expressive and receptive communication, motor planning, and sensory integration
