
Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Hashim was assessed at our center for follow-up on his developmental progress. The child has shown **significant improvement on the first step** of the therapeutic protocols. According to the **Precision Health Analysis previously conducted by Neurazon (Canada)**, genetic variants linked to **Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)** and other **phenotypically relevant markers** were identified, offering a clearer understanding of the biological underpinnings behind his symptoms.

While progress is evident, the child continues to exhibit challenges related to information processing and developmental delays, which require continued monitoring and targeted support.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Continue the non-medicinal intervention protocol for the next 4 months.
 - Preferably reevaluate the child in person to assess response.
 - Establish a new clinical baseline and update the therapeutic plan accordingly.
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Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

Recommended Therapy:

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:**
Intensive therapy is advised after 4 months of protocol completion to target higher-order processing, attention, and regulation of acquired features of autism.

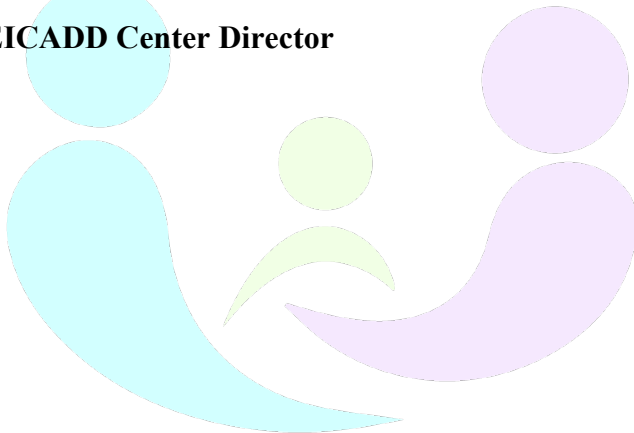


