Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Malak AL Masri visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation indicates that Malak has made significant improvement following the first protocol. However, she continues to present with information processing delays and developmental delays. Importantly, Malak does not meet the diagnostic criteria for Autism Spectrum Disorder or Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD).

These findings suggest the delays are isolated and responsive to intervention, and do not align with a neurodevelopmental disorder diagnosis at this stage.

Recommended Plan:

- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:
 - Continue with the development protocol for a duration of **4 months**.
 - o A reevaluation is recommended in person after this period to measure progress.
 - O During this period, establish a **clear baseline** and monitor for improvement.
- 2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):
 - O Please refer to the plan provided by Neurazon for further information. Please note that these are recommendations and not obligatory, and they are not conducted through our centers directly.
- 3. Recommended Therapy:
 - Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy (Intensive):
 - Frequency: 2 sessions per week

Conclusion:

This is a developmental assessment, not a final medical diagnosis. Malak AL Masri has shown promising improvement and is open for further progress. Continued intervention and appropriate reassessment will help ensure sustained developmental gains.
