Assessment Summary:

Zain Mohammad Sayahin was assessed at our center due to concerns about his cognitive development and learning abilities. The evaluation revealed that the child has **information processing delays**, **developmental delays**, and **learning difficulties**. Despite these challenges, Zain does not meet the diagnostic criteria for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).

The assessment indicates the presence of early developmental vulnerabilities requiring targeted therapy and additional analysis. With proper support, the child is expected to show measurable improvements over time.

Recommended Plan:



1) Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Initiate a specialized protocol to enhance information processing abilities.
- Continue the protocol for 4 months, followed by a reassessment, preferably in person.
- Establish a baseline to monitor the child's developmental progress and adjust the plan as needed.

2) Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

3) Recommended Therapy:

- Mitotherapy (Light Therapy):
 - o Frequency: 2 sessions per week
- Occupational Therapy (OT):
 - o Frequency: 1–2 sessions per week
- Speech Therapy (ST):
 - o Frequency: 2 sessions per week
