Assessment Summary:

Zain Mohammad Sayahin was assessed at our center due to concerns about his cognitive development and learning abilities. The evaluation revealed that the child has **information processing delays, developmental delays, and learning difficulties**. Despite these challenges, Zain **does not meet the diagnostic criteria for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)**.

The assessment indicates the presence of early developmental vulnerabilities requiring targeted therapy and additional analysis. With proper support, the child is expected to show measurable improvements over time.

Recommended Plan:

EICADD

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Initiate a specialized protocol to enhance information processing abilities.
- Continue the protocol for **4 months**, followed by a **reassessment**, preferably in person.
- Establish a baseline to monitor the child's developmental progress and adjust the plan as needed.

2) Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

- Please refer to their report and assessment.

3) Recommended Therapy:

- **Mitotherapy (Light Therapy):**
 - Frequency: 2 sessions per week
- **Occupational Therapy (OT):**
 - Frequency: 1–2 sessions per week
- **Speech Therapy (ST):**
 - Frequency: 2 sessions per week
