

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Date of Visit: 24-06-2025

Child's Name: Nour Hamza Jameel

Date of Birth: 30-04-2018

Overview:

Nour Hamza Jameel was assessed at our center for developmental concerns. The evaluation revealed **information processing delays**, as well as **delays in development and cognitive skills**. The child currently shows **acquired features of autism**, though this does not represent a final diagnosis. Further detailed analysis is needed to determine the underlying causes and define a long-term plan.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Non-Medicinal Protocol for Information Processing:

- Initiate or continue targeted developmental intervention for 4 months
- Reevaluate the child in person after 4 months
- Establish a new developmental baseline
- Adjust and continue the intervention plan as necessary
- Additional testing may be recommended after the next evaluation, depending on the child's progress


