

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Zayed Othman Sultan Alogaily Al Zaabi visited our center for a developmental assessment. The evaluation revealed information processing delays, cognitive developmental delay features, and learning difficulties. While the child displays some minor features that may resemble autism, he does not meet the diagnostic criteria for Autism Spectrum Disorder. The case is consistent with general developmental delay. Ongoing evaluation and personalized interventions are essential to support Zayed's cognitive and functional development.

Recommended Plan:

1. **Development Protocol for Information Processing:**
 - Continue a structured, non-medicinal intervention protocol.
 - Maintain this plan for 4 months.
 - Reevaluate the child in person to assess improvements and adjust the plan accordingly.
 - Establish a new developmental baseline during the follow-up evaluation.
2. **Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):**
 - Please refer to their report and assessment.
3. **Recommended Therapy:**
 - **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:**
 - Frequency: 2–3 sessions per week.
 - Begin therapy immediately to enhance Zayed's information processing, learning abilities, and developmental progress.

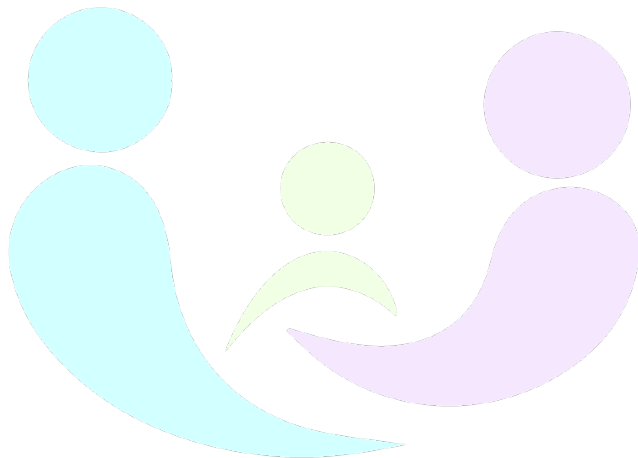
