Assessment Summary:

Amjad was assessed on 25-06-2025. The child shows signs of **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**that have contributed to **hyperlexia**, closer to **Hyperlexia Type 3**, with acquired features of autism. However, he does **not meet the criteria for autism**. Further analysis is required to determine the underlying factors and continue a personalized developmental support plan.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing



- Initiate a targeted, non-medicinal developmental protocol.
- Reevaluate the child after 4 months, preferably in person.
- Establish a new baseline and adapt the plan accordingly.
- Continue the protocol depending on the progress observed.
