Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Miaseen visited our center for a developmental assessment. The evaluation revealed signs of developmental delays and information processing challenges. Additionally, the child demonstrates characteristics aligned with hyperlexia, closer to Hyperlexia Type 2—categorized as acquired features of autism due to underlying delays. It is important to note that this is not a final diagnosis of autism but an assessment indicating areas that require targeted support and further evaluation.

Recommended Plan:

- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:
 - o Duration: 4 months
 - o Followed by an in-person reevaluation
 - o Reestablish baseline and adjust interventions accordingly
 - o Continue with the existing tailored developmental plan

Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

Recommended Therapy:

- Initiate therapy in the child's home country
- Begin **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy** intensively as soon as possible to support information processing and developmental recovery
